A carer is someone of any age who provides unpaid support to family or friends who cannot manage without this help due to illness, disability, mental ill-health or a substance misuse problem.

Carers are the largest source of care and support in each area of the UK. There are currently 13.6 million carers living in the United Kingdom, with 77,432 carers living in Derbyshire (excluding Derby City) (from the 2021 census).
